# Maximum Growth Potential (part 1)

"I have come that you may have life, and have it to the full" (Jesus – John 10:10)

Since you received Jesus Christ into your life — since you placed your faith & trust in Him for salvation and the promise of Heaven — you are a new person (2 Corinthians 5:17). This "new you" has the capacity to live a life that exemplifies a Christ-like character. #### The Holy Spirit

Living the Christian life on our own is not difficult ... it's impossible!

Living a Christ-like life cannot be done in our own strength. Jesus said, apart from Him we can do nothing (John 15:5).

In our independent & self-centered thinking we struggle against the concept and practice of a total dependency upon God to live a righteous life. We often try to live by our own strength until we realize it won't work – and we become so frustrated we want to quit.

#### The Spirit-filled life is the Abundant Life

#### Natural Person (Self-Directed Life)

Self is on the throne, directing decisions and actions (represented by the dots), often resulting in frustration. Jesus is outside the life.



### Spiritual Person (Christ-Directed Life)

Jesus is in the life and on the throne. Self is yielding to Jesus. The person sees Jesus' influence and direction in their life.



#### Carnal Person (Self-Directed Life)

Jesus is in the life but not on the throne. Self is on the throne, directing decisions and actions (represented by the dots), often resulting in frustration.
